3. Graphica

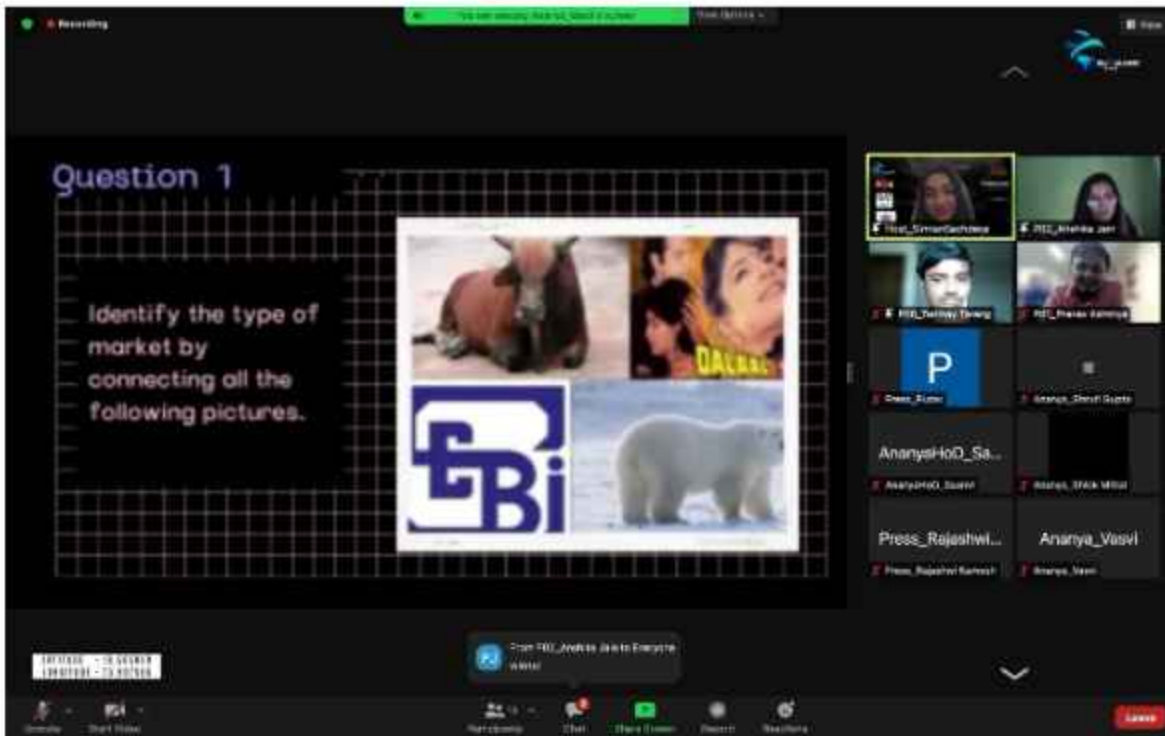

2. IPL Auction - Day 1

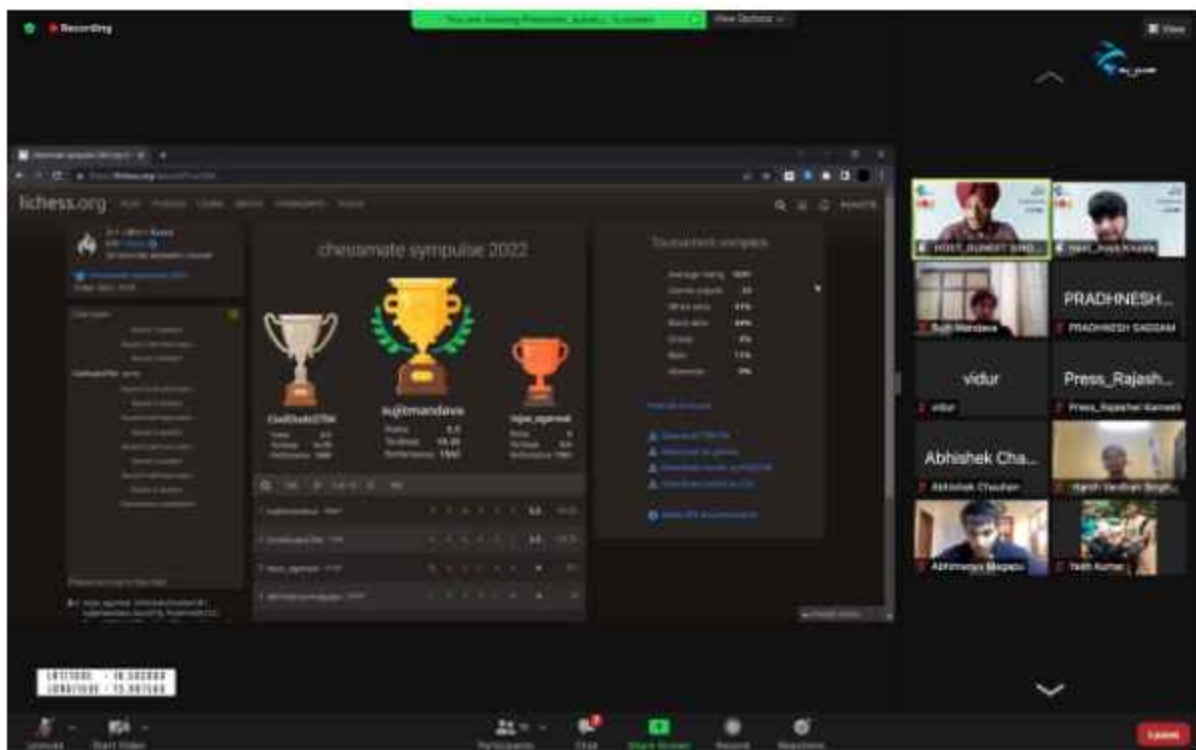

Symulate's "Best Manager" event put these skills to the test. It was an exciting and dynamic event that forced participants to venture outside of their comfort zones and put their skills to good use. Arnav Chopra, Aryan Doiphode, and Ethan Emmanuel Vaz hosted the event.

The first round started with the host mailing the topics to the participants at 10:45 a.m. The

participants were given a total of one hour to make a PPT about their topics and thereby present the same according to the time slots given to them. Round one (BMW Regional Manager) consisted of the participants being given various situations and asked to create a ppt presentation in 45 minutes. They had to use their strategic thinking for this round and act as the religion manager for BMW in various states (Gujarat, Hyderabad, Assam, Punjab, Haryana, Karnataka, Uttar Pradesh, West Bengal, Mumbai). Participants gave their terrific presentation starting at 11:30 and then the host counter questioned them.

Round 2 started with yet another competitive spirit among the top participants. The participants were then allotted allegations, on which they had to do some research and submit a report within a 40-minute time limit. After submission of the report, each participant had to present their report in front of a panel of judges who later cross-questioned the former's presentation. The participant took on the role of Andy Wenlock, the managing director of Gordon Ramsay Holdings, a restaurant. They were given different negative claims against Gordon Ramsay and had to make defensive remarks in 35 minutes. This round required participants to think imaginatively and respond quickly to the counter questions. The best candidates were promoted to the next round which was held the following day.

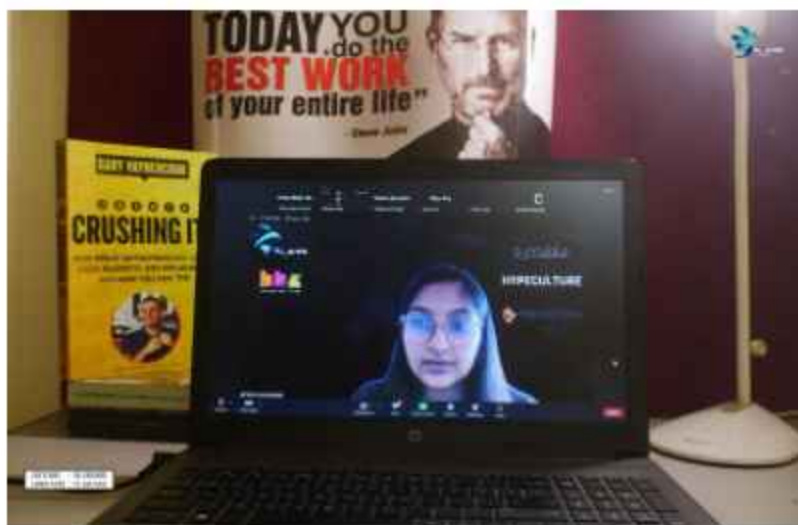
Event Summary:

Symulate is the business wing of Sympulse, the finance event marked the onset of Sympulse 22. The event consisted of various rounds which tested the skills and understanding of the participants regarding finance and its instruments. The event saw participants competing to be crowned as the “Master of Finance”.

Round one, Capitalcopia tested financial decision making as well as analytical skills. It started at 10:30 am where participants were greeted by the hosts and had to compete in an investing round. Each participant was given a hypothetical amount of 1 crore rupees which they had to invest using their financial knowledge about financial markets and other instruments like PPF. Participants were given time to create a presentation for their investment analysis and they presented it individually. The hosts asked questions regarding the investments to test their understanding. After which Participants were given a break before round 2.

The second round, Battle of Lands, assessed the revenue generation ability of the participants. This round was divided in three segments, each designed in a way to cover all the aspects of finance and its analysis. In the first segment, the participants were provided with a series of data from which they had to extract useful information and make their investments accordingly. In the second segment, participants were free to leave the meet to make presentations regarding the data, where every participant duly performed the task and came up with creative presentations. The third segment consisted of showing and explaining their presentation one by one followed by questions from the host.
