Event Summary:

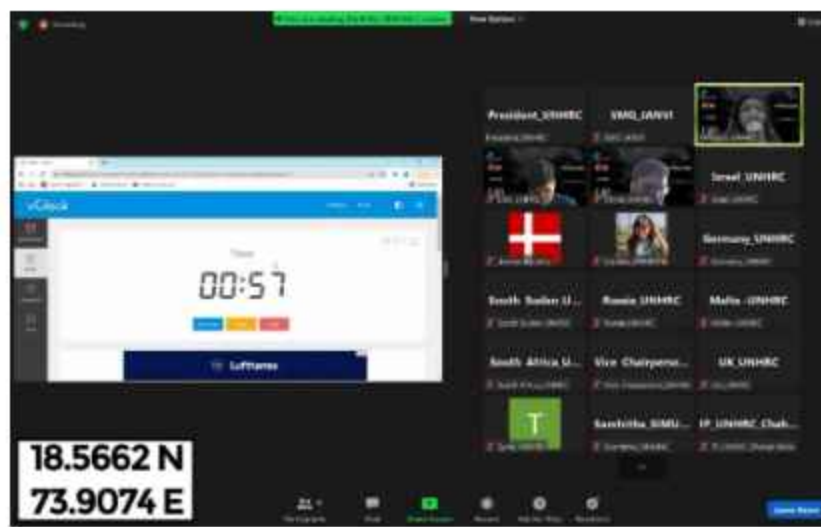

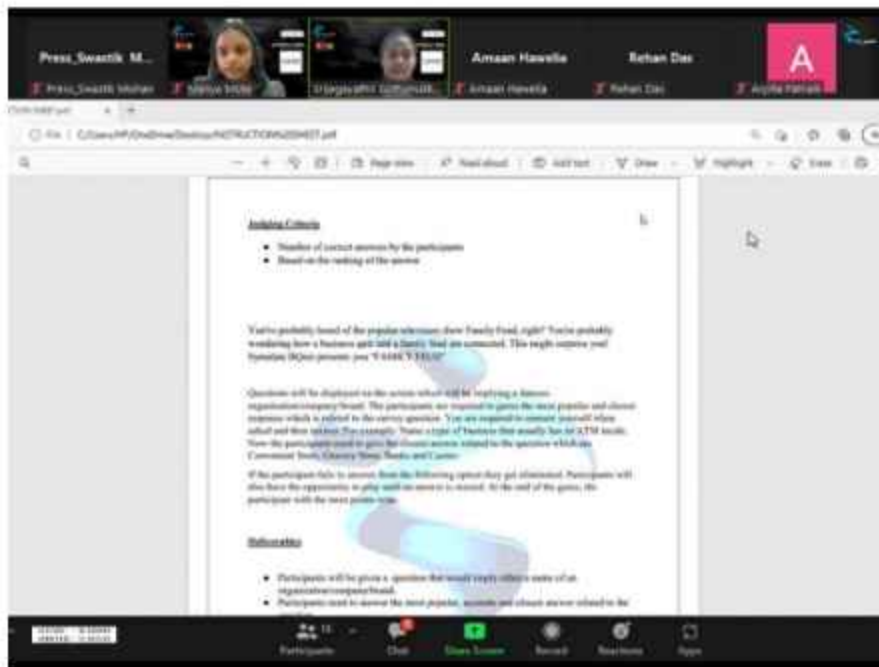
