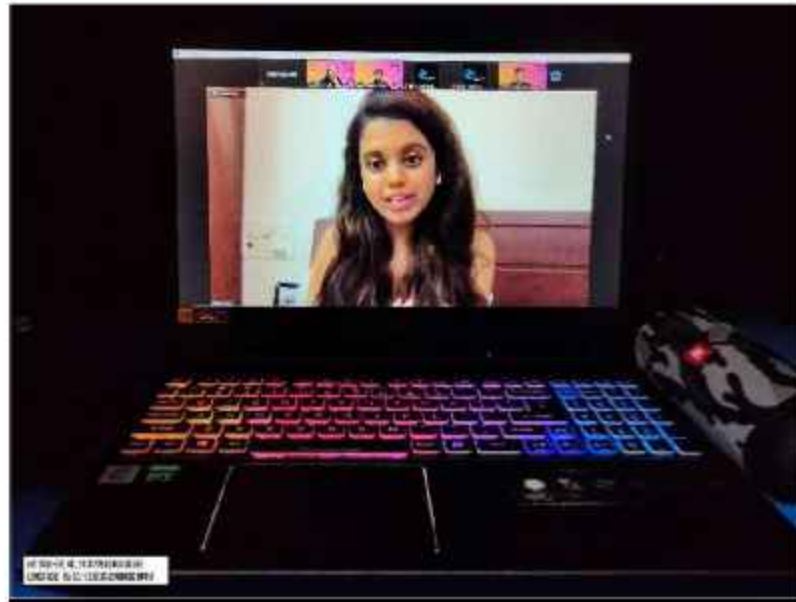
Event Summary:
